### Age UK Community Helpline

In March of this year, Age UK in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly launched a Community Helpline, to help individuals, carers, families and health and social care practitioners, to navigate their way around services and support in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly.

The aim of the Helpline is to support people in finding the right help, at the right time, from

the right person, reducing health inequalities, tackling social exclusion and improving the wellbeing of the population in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly. In the first 3 months of its launch the Helpline supported a total of 1528 individuals.

They are also offering hospital to home support through an Integrated Care Team. The team is currently based at Royal Cornwall Hospital and West Cornwall Hospital. The Care Team visit individuals on the ward, identify needs and work with discharge & community teams and local volunteers, enabling individuals to get home safely with ongoing community support. So far the project has supported 74 people. Helping them get back safely and seamlessly into the community.

### **Clients being supported**

We have had quite a number of new referrals again this month and still have 4 clients to be assessed. This means that we have a number of people waiting for befrienders and will be contacting volunteers this week. We are actively supporting 68 elderly people through our befriending scheme and almost another 65 through clubs, classes and events.

### **Dementia Friendly Walking Group and activities at the Potager**

The Potager and Sensory Trust continue to hold their activity mornings fortnightly for people living with dementia and their carers. Dates for the summer are:
